NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.

1.2 Class rules of each competing class will apply.

1.3 Where the Sailing Instructions or Notice of Race differ from a boat's class rules, the Sailing Instructions or Notice of Race shall prevail.

1.4 Racing rules 26, 35, A4, A5, 44.1, 62.1(a), 62.2, and 66 will be changed as follows:

26 – Three minute start sequences will be used.

A4, A5 – Boats starting later than 2 minutes after her start signal will be scored DNS.

35, A4, A5 – Boats failing to finish within time limit will be scored DNF without a hearing.

44.1 – The two-turns penalty is replaced with a one-turn penalty.

62.1(a) – Failure to meet target times will not be grounds for redress.

62.2 – On the last day, requests for redress based on protest committee decisions is reduced to 30 minutes.

66 – The time to request a re-opening of a hearing changed to 30 minutes.

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising must be compliant with ISAF Regulation 20 (2009 update).

2.1 Event sponsorship shall be at the discretion of the organizing authorities and hosting sailing club. This may require competitors and/or their boats to carry temporary advertising as deemed appropriate.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all eligible boats of the following classes:

Skiffs : International 14, International Canoe, Vanguard Vector, 29er, Contender, Laser 5000, 49er, Quetzal.

Catamarans: F-18, Tornado, Mystere, Hobie, Dart.

Other types: On application to the Race Organizers.

3.2 Eligible boats should pre-register on line at www.osrf.ca/grandprix.html before June 4th at 12:00.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and delivering it together with the entry fee to the Nepean Sailing Club during the scheduled registration period.

3.4 Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Regatta Chair.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Double Handed boats	\$90
Single Handed Boats	\$60

Entrance fee includes Saturday night dinner for all competitors. Extra dinner tickets may be purchased at registration.

6 MEASUREMENT

There shall be no scheduled measurement or inspection. However, the race committee reserves the right to inspect any boat or equipment at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be as follows:

I-14s, 49'er, Catamarans – Windward / Leeward,

All other skiffs - Windward / Leeward Triangle.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1 For all class(es) rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

11 SCORING

11.1 The Ottawa Skiff Fleet Handicap will apply.

11.2 The Low Point System of the RRS Appendix A will apply.

11.3 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.4 (a) When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from five to six races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

- (c) When seven or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

12 OFFICIAL BOATS

Official boats will be marked with a green shape.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

Coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first start until all boats have finished racing.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the three highest finishing boats in each Division.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 Cdn. per event or the equivalent.
